How many arbitrations have you participated in (domestic/international)? Under which Rules? – I’ve participated in arbitration governed by ICAC rules, ICC rules, SCC rules and rules of Russian domestic arbitral institutions. I’ve participated in 5-8 arbitrations.

How often have you acted as Chairman? - So far, I have not acted as Chairman.

How often have you acted as Sole Arbitrator? - So far, I have not acted as Sole Arbitrator.

How often have you acted as Co-Arbitrator? - I acted as Co-Arbitrator in proceedings in domestic arbitral institution several times. I am also included into the list of arbitrators of Russian arbitration association, but have not acted as arbitrator so far.

How often have you acted as Counsel? – I represent clients in litigation for more than 10 years (more that 200 proceedings over these years). I also represent clients in arbitration, though, number of arbitrations is less and is about 5-8 cases.

How often have you acted in a different function (e.g. Administrative Secretary)? –

Within my litigation practice, I usually draft pleadings which can be used by judges as a basis for a judgment (these pleadings are submitted for a convenience of judges and for saving their time).
